About The Artists:

Collins Pratt

Collins Brian Ade Pratt, a.k.a 'De Champ' has been in the music industry for four decades. The sounds of his musical instruments have resounded in scores of churches and community halls, crossing continents as well as popular, dance music, and highlife genres. His second album, which included popular tracks like *We nor tire* took the Sierra Leonean diaspora by storm and led to tours in the UK, the USA, Sierra Leone, and a total of 14 albums to date.

In 1998, De champ recorded his first gospel album entitled, E go well with di Righteous,

Collins has also produced music for folk and pop stars like Bunny Mack (*Let Me Love You*) and SE Rogie (*My Lovely Elizabeth*); King Masco and John Gbla.

Collins produced, arranged and recorded the hit song *We lek we Salone* with Bunny Mack (writer) and King Masco.

With this experience under his belt, he was able to start the Dechamp Music Academy in Camberwell, London in 2007 teaching young, gifted and talented musicians. In recent years, he has made strides to help children and adults in Sierra Leone achieve their goals through a Music Academy, which offers skills training and education.

A recipient of no less than 12 awards and globally recognized certificates, the addition of a British Empire Medal (BEM) in the 2019 New Year Honors means Collins is the winner of the highest accolade ever given to a musician of Sierra Leonean descent.

Drizilik

With over seven million streams, an award-winning debut album, and sold out concerts, Drizilik, real name Benjamin Menalik George, is the breakout star of Freetown's music revival scene which is a fusion of Sierra Leonean goombay, bubu, and milo jazz, with hip-hop and afrobeat. His skillful songwriting, catchy one-liners, and deep cultural metaphors on his 10-track Album of the Year winning Shukubly record, earned him the moniker of Sierra Leone's *king of new school music*. Drizilik's range and inimitable delivery both as a rapper and singer have led to back-to-back hit singles and collaborations including 'Shukubly', 'Move Right' with BAFTA winner Big Zuu, and the grimey classic 'Di Mammy Im Moni Fo Komot'. The 2021 MTV Africa Music Award 'Listener's Choice' Nominee has rocked stages from Freetown, Lagos, to London; including Madengn Festival, Fashion Week for Labrum, Youtube's Africa Day Concert, Sierra Leone & Gambia Music Festival, and Hull City's Freedom Festival.

DJ Rampage

Reginald "DJ Rampage" Daramy, a multi-instrumentalist, producer, and disk jockey.

Famous

Frederick Dapaye Peters, known professionally as Famous, is a versatile artist blending highlife and hiphop influences. With five studio albums under his belt, including the award-winning "Noto Alman Go Lek U," Famous has solidified his status as a trailblazer in the music scene. Honoured as the 2012 All Works of Life (AWOL) Artist of the Year, he continues to leave an indelible mark on the industry under the banner of Forensic Records.

The chart topping hit maker behind "Sebeh - Na For Luk Unda U Foot", "Love Tite", "Ar Nor Know", "Tell Me" and "Brighter Future" continues to thrill Sierra Leonean audiences both at home and abroad.

Freetown Uncut Band

Freetown Uncut Band is a multi-instrumental, multi-talented group of musicians who arrange, produce and make music with the goal of changing the narrative of music in Sierra Leone and Africa. With a versatility that ranges from hip hop to R&B to afrobeat to gospel and more, they are known for their own original compositions and backing some of the biggest names in Sierra Leonean music today.

I-Tribe

I-Tribe, real name Leonard Massaquoi, is a talented singer, song writer, composer, performer and entertainer. He represented Sierra Leone at Project Fame West Africa in Nigeria in 2013. This new school vocalist has taken the music industry by storm with his chart-topping 2023 hit, "Nobody. He is also well-known for successful collaborations with Rozzy Sokota with lyrics narrating the trials, tribulations and strength of romantic relationships.

Kao Denero

Amara Dennis Turay, popularly known as Kao Denero, is a young Sierra-Leonean rap artist and songwriter. He is also the founder of Black Leo Entertainment, his music outfit which has more than a hundred recorded songs to it.

Kao Denero, currently regarded as a successful rap artist in Sierra Leone, released his first album in 2003 called Black Leo 4 Life. However, he came into the limelight after his second album called Stories From Freetown, where he featured Big Joe in a very popular track; Emonah, bagging him an award at the Premier Music Awards. In 2009, he won an SLMTV Music Award in Maryland, U.S. He was also nominated in the 'African Rapper of the Year' category by the 256 HipHop Awards in 2020. Kao Denero recently won the African entertainment award as the best hip-hop artist of the year in 2021. And boasts collaborations with Grammy winning acts like Shaba Ranks, Ghana's Sarkodie, Nigeria's Runtown as well as well, Jamaica's

dancehall guru, Busy Signal...

In March 2021, Kao Denero was appointed as the first Ambassador of Entertainment and Investment by H.E President Rtd Brig Julius Maada Bio.

Rozzy Sokota

Rozzy Sokota, real name Rosemarie Baryoh, is a versatile and well known R&B and afrobeats singer and songwriter.

From singing gospel she moved on to secular songs and her signature voice has seen her rise through the ranks to the position of top female vocalist in Sierra Leone representing several corporate brands.

Star Zee

Multi-talented award-winning hip-hop and dancehall artist, Star Zee, born Linda Samai. Star Zee enrolled in various performing arts groups and was first exposed to the music industry at the age of 14 when she joined Stress Inc Records, later forming part of an all-female group called L.D.O (Ladies Day Out). After much success with LD.O she went solo in 2003 and hasn't looked back. Since the launch of her solo career, Star Zee has released five albums, the last of which is titled "Collabo." She has been on tour in the United Kingdom, and Australia, and performs regularly with other artists from her country and outside its shores, including a performance with Nigerian star Patoranking. Star Zee recently collaborated with international dancehall heavyweight, Stonebwoy, which earned her an award for "Best Collaboration of the Year."

Shady Baby

Renowned entertainer Shadrack, affectionately known as Shady Baby. With a career spanning back to 2004, Shady Baby has long been celebrated for his exceptional musical talent and electrifying stage presence.

Known for his infectious energy and chart-topping hits like 'Nor Go Taya' and Me Yone Style", Shady Baby's earlier works established him as a force to be reckoned with in the entertainment industry.

Telem Uncommon Sounds

Nurturing an open and experimental creative community in Freetown, Sierra Leone, Telem Uncommon Sounds is an 8-piece band that seeks to bring about a brilliant new era in music in Sierra Leone. Founded by three local singer-songwriters and working with a team of extended musicians and performing artists, Telem offers training in songwriting and music production, stages concerts and other live events, and works to develop the vibrant Sierra Leone music ecosystem. The global culture craves what Africa has to offer, and Telem wants to help put Sierra Leonean musicians at the forefront of that demand.
